ConnectMed International, a non-profit public charity, has been using this technology in Africa, India, Guatemala and Mexico, providing reconstructive surgical services for the treatment of congenital and acquired deformities since 2010.

Dear CMI Supporters:

ConnectMed International was founded in 2010 as a vision to provide not only surgical services for the treatment of congenital and acquired deformities but to promote sustainable multidisciplinary health care and education through the use of telemedicine.

In fiscal year 2013, you helped us continue our work in Tijuana, Mexico and take our first surgical outreach trip to Malawi, Africa where 40 children received life altering surgeries, 175 evaluations were performed and 25 children received audiology therapy.

Real responsibility begins after surgery, and CMI is working to establish on going interactive telemedicine network sites in Vietnam, Malawi and the continuation of our successful program in Mexico.

Healthcare in emerging countries is often times inadequate and the combination of surgical support combined with telemedicine creates an educational environment which is essential in the long term care of our patients.

Financials

ConnectMed International relies on donated medical supplies, equipment and volunteers so that the majority of our donations go to direct patient costs. We partner with local medical personnel so that our patients receive the follow up care with their providers that they need in the following months after surgery.

ConnectMed International files a Form 990 with the Internal Revenue Department each year in compliance with our 501 (C) (3) public charity status.

The eight members of the CMI Board of Directors are comprised of medical, legal and business leaders to ensure that CMI donated funds and the use of all assets are used for the highest level of charitable purposes.
